7. Do read the school rules mentioned in the almanac and fill the personal & medical record in the almanac without fail. Communication between parents and teachers will be done through the relevant pages of the Almanac.
8. Any packet /material or lunch box sent to the child in the school will not be accepted for security reasons.
9. Please attend all the PTMs that you are invited for.
10. If you need to meet Coordinator/Principal, kindly take a prior appointment through the almanac.
11. Kindly don't call to talk to teachers during school hours & don't ask for the personal contact no. of teachers.
12. Extravagant Birthday celebrations are not permitted in school. The children may distribute candies though. Please note that cakes/pastries/expensive items are not permitted.
13. The child will not be handed over to any person without the presentation of Parent I-Card.
